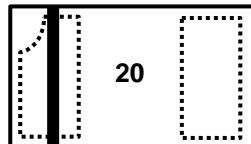
Device Schematic

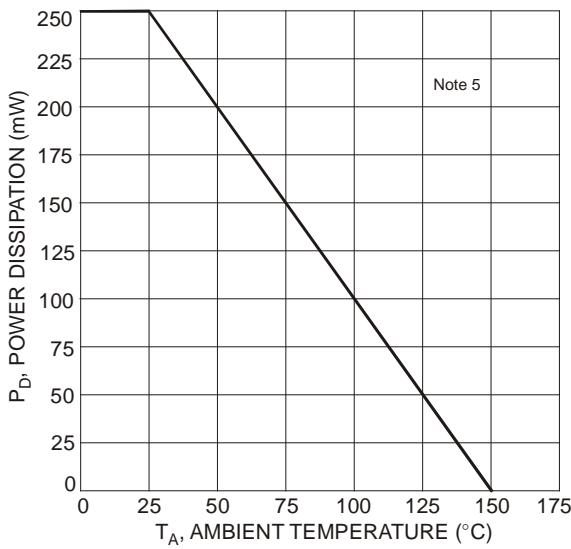


Figure 1 Power Derating Curve

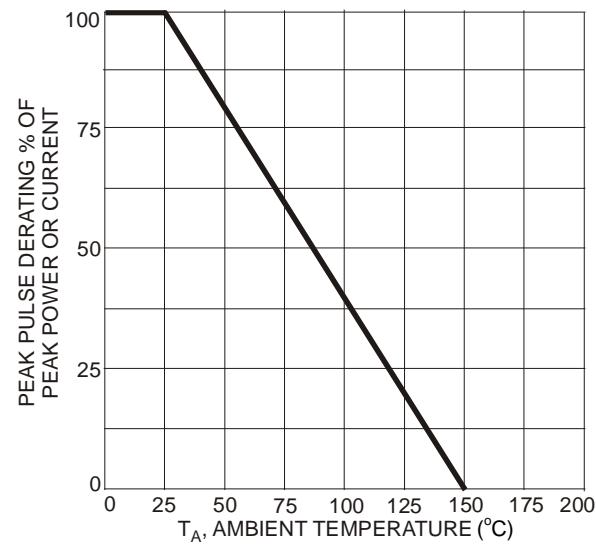


Figure 2 Pulse Derating Curve

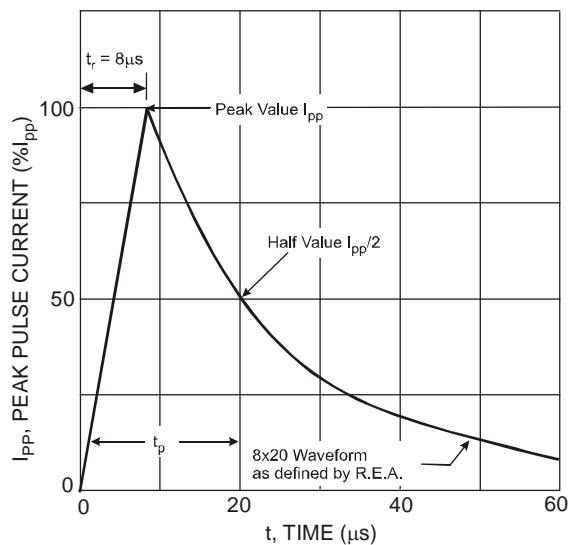


Figure 3 Typical 8 × 20 $\mu$ s Pulse Waveform

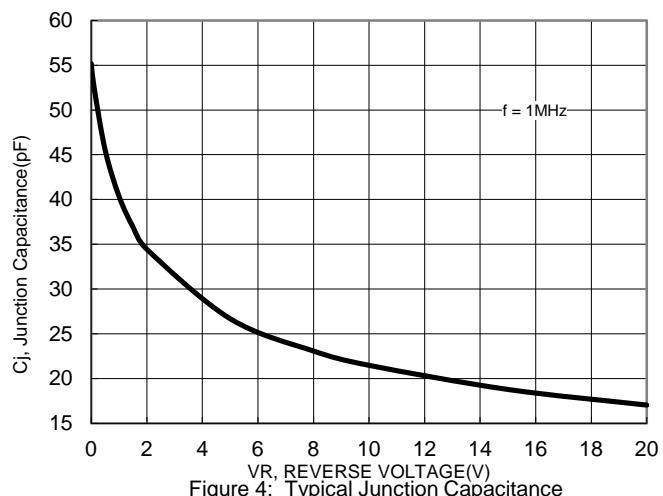


Figure 4: Typical Junction Capacitance

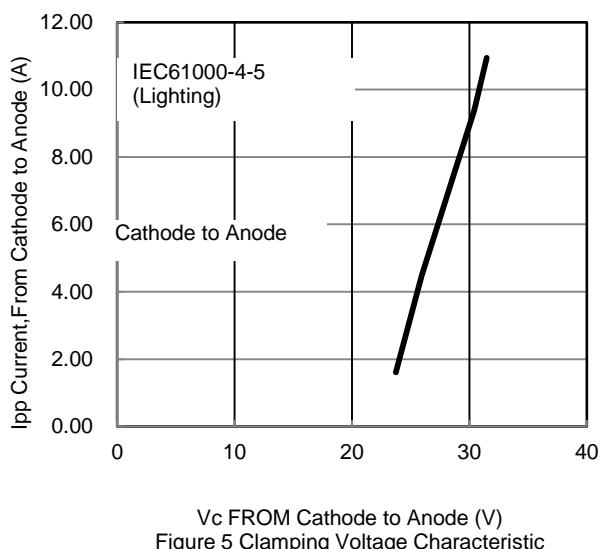
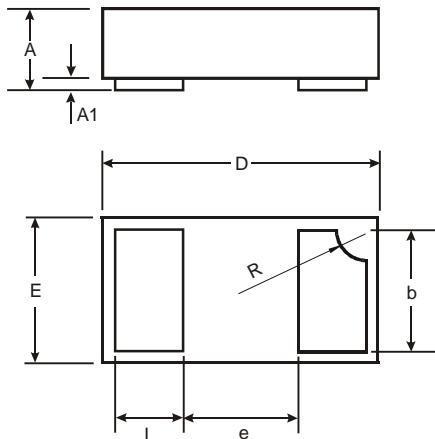


Figure 5 Clamping Voltage Characteristic

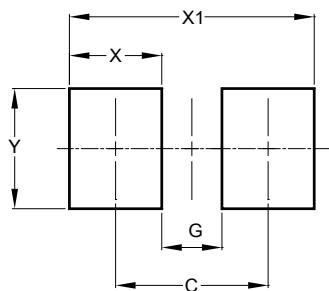
